Established in 1950, Iowa Health Care Association (IHCA), including its divisions the Iowa Center for Assisted Living (ICAL) and the Iowa Center for Home Care (IHC), is the state's largest organization of long term services and supports providers, representing skilled nursing facilities, assisted living programs, residential care facilities, home health providers and senior living communities. IHCA's 760+ member provider organizations represent over 85 percent of long term services and supports providers in both urban and rural Iowa. IHCA is the voice of quality long term services and supports in Iowa.

About Associate Membership

An IHCA Associate Membership allows businesses and organizations that supply goods and/or services to the long term services and supports profession to connect with potential customers in a number of ways not available to non-members.

Convention and Trade Show - Associate Members receive a Trade Show booth at a reduced rate (first-come, first-serve) and are listed as a Member Exhibitor in the Convention Program Guide. The event, held each fall in Des Moines, is attended by 1,000 of our member administrators, owners, nurses, department heads and staff members.

Association Member Mailing List - Upon request, Associate Members are provided with a list of IHCA member providers in Excel format.

Member Communications - The Associate Member's designated staff member receives the IHCA online newsletters with the latest on trends and issues affecting Iowa's long term services and supports providers. A link to the Associate Member list is available to all member providers via our website and weekly newsletter.

Member Education - Associate Members can attend IHCA education programs and seminars at the members-only reduced rate. This includes the annual convention, district meetings and seminars held at locations all across the state.

Professional Connection - IHCA's professional staff serves as a resource to answer questions for Associate Members about serving the needs of Iowa's long term services and supports providers.
