

## How to Register for an Event

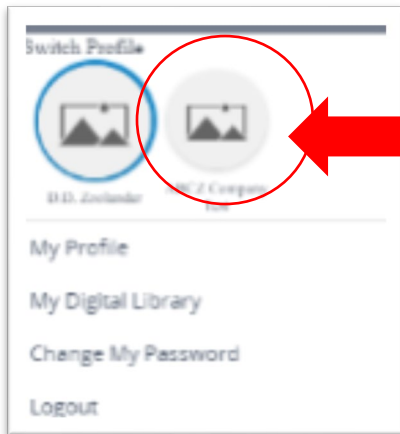
This training is for the organization’s Primary Executive Admin and identifies how to register groups or individuals for IHCA educational events, including conferences, in-person trainings and webinars.

**Registration should be done by the organization’s Primary Executive Admin** (i.e., the administrator or designated individual who has access to your organization’s information in the Member Portal).

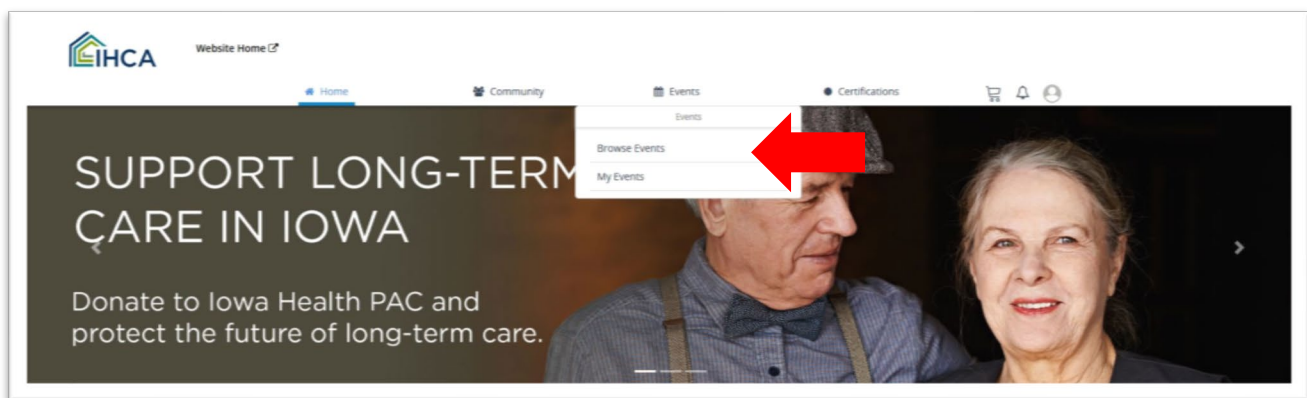
Contact your administrator or IHCA at 800-422-3106 to determine who is your Primary Executive Admin.

### How to Register

1. From the IHCA home page, select the Member Portal Logo, and then select the Access the Member Portal button.
2. Log in to the Member Portal **and select your Organizational Profile if you are the Primary Executive Admin.**



3. Select the **Events** option in the top menu bar, and then **Browse Events**.



4. Click on the Event Listing for the event.

The Patient Driven Payment Models (PDPM) implementation will be as significant to MDS Coordinators as was OBRA 1988 and MDS 3.0 in 2010. It is critical to understand the vital role the MDS plays in the new payment model.

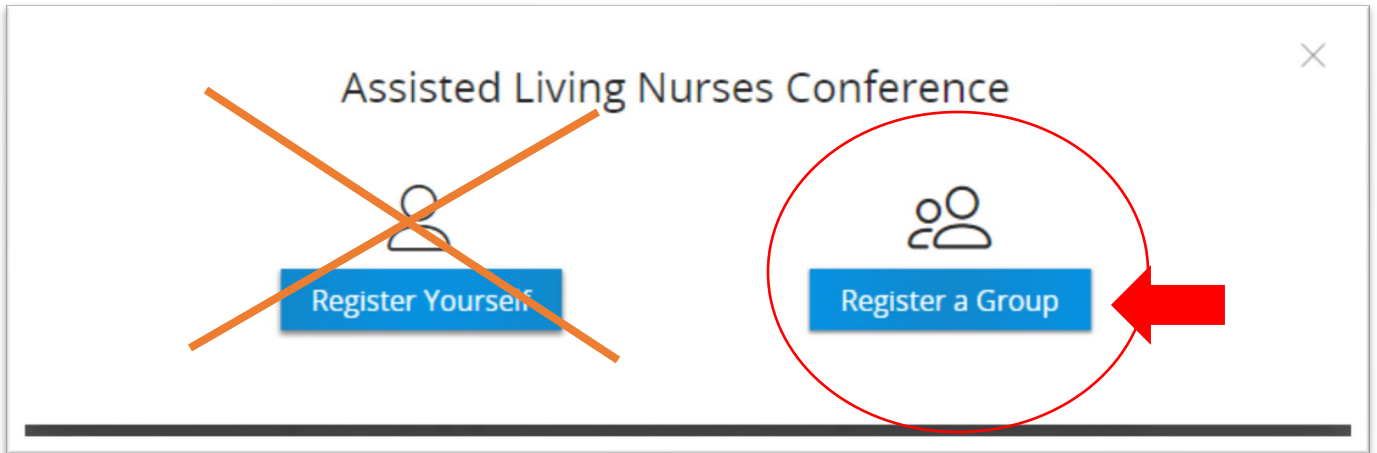

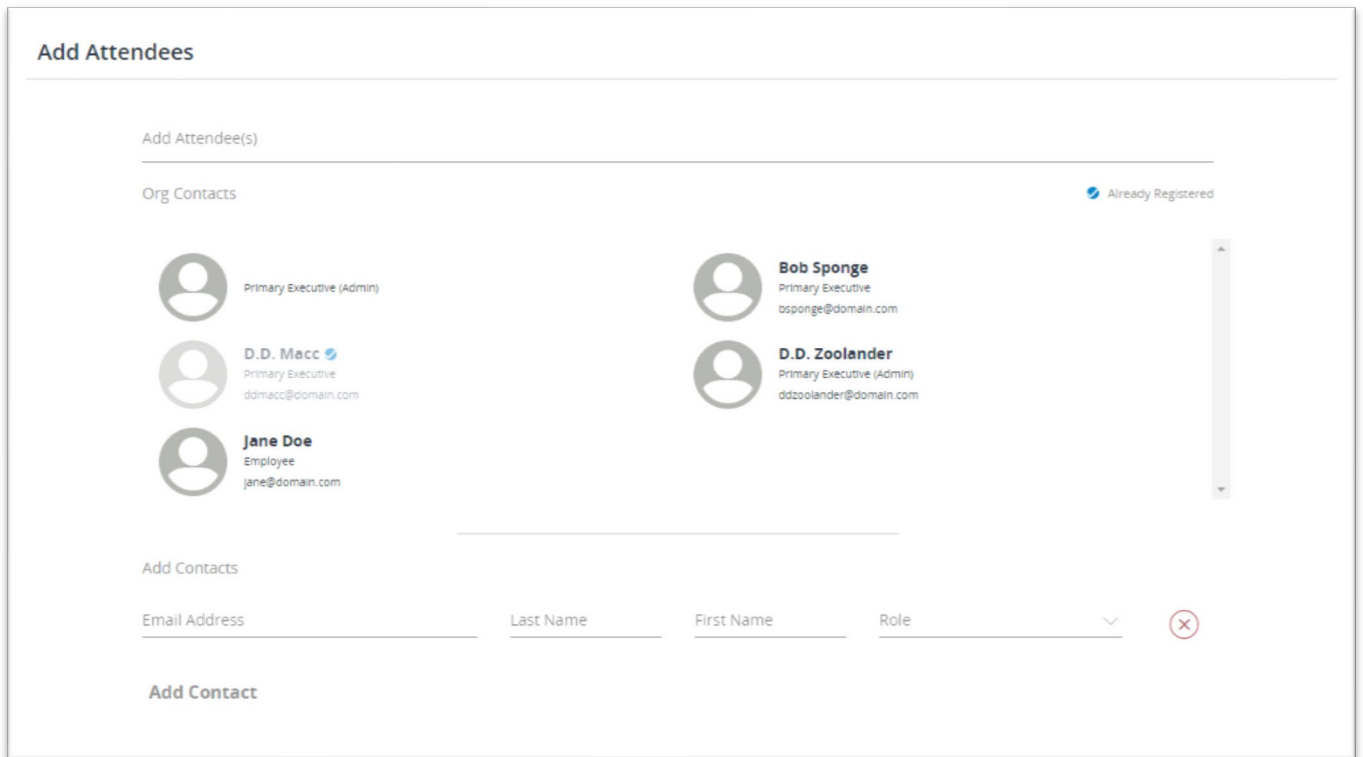

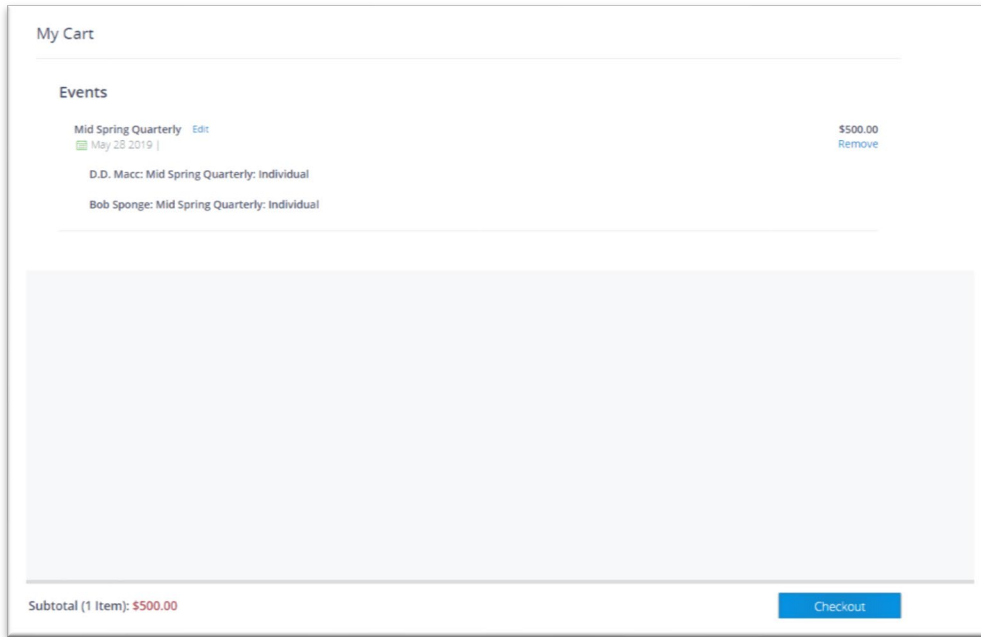
